Collaborative Facilitation of Full-Day, In-Person Design Studios

- Facilitate Design Studios for knowledge, skill, and mindset development
- Studios are in-person and bring together the regional cohort of school teams
- These are fun and fast-paced professional learning experiences focused on activating educators’ capacity. While our process is the same for every school, each is focused on their own unique challenges and opportunities throughout the process, resulting in a personalized professional learning experience and school-based innovations that reflect the school’s specific needs, challenges, and opportunities.

Supporting School Design Team between Studios

- One-on-one learning-focused meetings and check-ins with each School Design Team.
- Thought-partnership as teams problem-solve, solution-build, and engage in rapid cycle design to learn and improve fast
- Personalized support for teams as they apply the new skills gained in the Studios and take action.
- Tracking School Design Team progress, accountability, and providing actionable feedback
- Building positive relationships that encourage and inspire School Design Teams to think purposefully, big and bold about improving student experiences and outcomes.
